Vision Casting

This is a brief introduction to wholistic ministry for the local church. Great for settings such as cell groups, bible studies, leadership meetings, or Sunday school classes. Can be done in 2-6 hours.

Vision Conference

This is usually a 2-3 day conference designed to provide local churches with an overview of biblical worldview concepts, leadership development, and wholistic ministry strategies and tools. The goal is for the local churches to embrace this vision and their role to be incarnational ministers in their communities. Those people impacted by a vision casting event often seek to hold a Vision Conference for a larger group of people.

• Basics I & II

This is a unique wholistic discipleship curriculum that pastors or lay leaders can use to guide new and mature believers in the practice of Jesus' commands in all areas of life.

- Local Church Ministry Training I & II
 This is a training tool for church leaders who

 neighbors. It offers vision, theology, and practical strategy.
- Vision Conference
 Trains churches how to hold their own vision conferences.

Module Trainings

 Prepares those who have a heart for the poor to use worldview as a tool to expose the false principles that imprison people living in poverty, and to create a framework for seeing through the lens of truth in order that people may discover God's vision for their community.
- Biblical Foundations for Wholistic Ministry
 Introduces the topic of wholistic ministry to churches
 and leaders. It discusses the biblical foundations for why
 wholistic ministry needs to be an essential ministry of
 the church and also provides practical applications for
 community transformation and service by the church.
- Seed Projects: The Power of Love to Transform Communities Introduces the tool of Discipline of Love to believers to

help them develop of a discipline of showing love to their family, churches, and communities. Also introduces the Seed Projects to local churches to help them develop the habit of reaching out to serve those outside the church with small demonstrations of God's love.

 Community Development Skills for the Local Church

A broad collection of skill building exercises and articles to equip churches to serve their neighbors in need. Includes topics such as participator learning, leadership, and project management.

 Biblical Perspectives on Resources and Development

Seeks to find a Biblical answer and understanding to the questions: What resources are needed for development, and where do these resources come from? Helps churches to see the many resources God has provided and will provide right there in their own communities!

 Understanding the Kingdom of God Introduces key characteristics of God's kingdom as well as provides an overview of God's strategy and your role in building His Kingdom here on earth.
