INDEPENDENT STUDY CONFIRMS DNA'S GLOBAL IMPACT

In 2025, a third party impact study found that DNA is “**exceptionally effective**” in transforming individuals and communities through biblical worldview training.

“I used to think that being spiritual meant staying away from work, politics, or anything outside the church. Now I realized these are lies.”

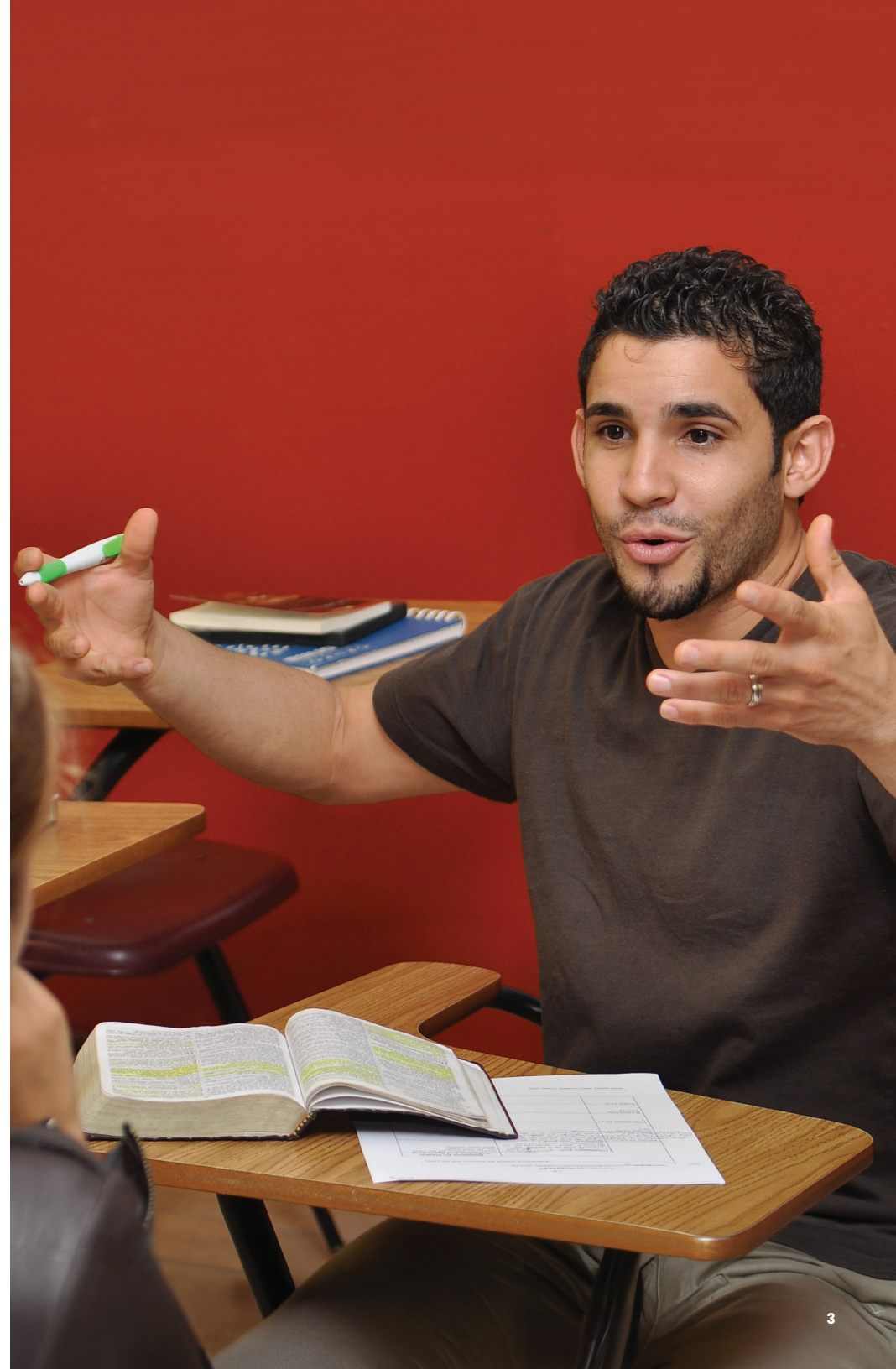
“I used to think God could only use pastors or missionaries for his kingdom. Now, I truly believe He can use me and my talent, arts, and everyday work to disciple nations.”

The study found:

Worldviews transformed – from compartmentalized faith to the conviction that all of life is sacred.

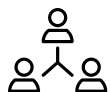
WHO WE ARE

Theme: The Essential Role of the Local Church in Discipling Nations

What is the Forum?

As an international alliance of key leaders around the world, we often lack regular in-person connection with our fellow DNA Kingdomizers. We like to think of our Forums as “family gatherings,” which provide a rare and powerful time for trainers and practitioners across various nations and sectors of society to join together to share best practices and be inspired by the work of God in biblical worldview transformation around the globe.

A Couple Testimonies That Left Us in Awe:

- After attending a DNA conference 30 years ago, an organization was formed by Nicaraguans that equips and educates more than 80 pastors each year where no theological education is available.
- One leader caught a vision from DNA for national discipleship in the biblical worldview across Paraguay. Through networking, programs, and opportunities that are still ongoing, 1708 leaders have now been trained across age groups and geographical regions.

We also heard the following story about the transformation of the Krinkrin village...

Evangelism Without Discipleship?

Too often, evangelized peoples are “saved for heaven,” but they are not disciplined in a biblical worldview. As such, their communities remain mired in brokenness, poverty, and injustice.

With DNA’s biblical worldview discipleship, we see individuals not only respond to the Gospel, but begin to increasingly honor Christ in every area of their lives, culture, and communities. Communities look different after being disciplined in a biblical worldview, and that creates interest from a watching world.

Have a look at how one community changed as a result of biblical worldview training:

A Culture of Thievery Transformed with a Biblical Worldview

About an eight-hour boat ride along the Coco River brought church planter, Emel Morales, to the remote unreached people in the village of Krinkrin, Nicaragua. Here, poverty wasn’t just material. Theft was the cultural norm. If something wasn’t nailed down, it disappeared. People spent their days guarding their small plots of land with spears and clubs. There were no businesses, little education, and no motivation to work beyond bare survival.

Morales, equipped with DNA’s training made a long-term move to the community and focused not only on evangelism, but on discipling the people with the whole counsel of God – teaching about honesty, work, property, and loving one’s neighbor. As minds were renewed, habits changed.



A simple test said it all:

A publicly-accessible water filter and cup, placed where everything used to be stolen, remained in place for two years. Even a smartphone left out for hours stayed exactly where it was.



Today, in that same village, people are cultivating more land, running a mill, operating businesses, and selling surplus crops to other communities. No major projects. No cash injections. Just the power of biblical truth applied to every area of life.

This is the type of profound change communities can experience as a result of biblical worldview training.

TESTIMONIES FROM KINGDOMIZERS: Multiplying Influence

“We are currently developing a district hospital into a national teaching hospital in rural Malawi. We have used the DNA Coram Deo videos to train faculty and can see the impact of the mindset change achieved through your resources.

Additionally, we train students, villagers, and children. We have contextualized the material for the local culture and now have a community center that runs **four classes a week with 30 participants per class**. With partners across Africa, **we reach more than 6,000 people each year**.

We are grateful for the many testimonies of how this has changed people’s lives for the better, helping them move out of poverty or leave behind the witchcraft that is common in traditional African cultures.”
